

Susan G. Scott - Biography

Susan G. Scott was born in Montreal, Quebec. In 1966 she left to study painting at *Pratt Institute* in New York and subsequently attended fine art schools in Boston, Maine, Montreal, and finally the *New York Studio School of Drawing and Painting* in 1972. She returned to Canada in 1980 to teach in Vancouver, B.C. and has since taught in schools throughout North America. She currently teaches at *Concordia University* in Montreal. Scott has had many one person and group shows, including three solo exhibitions that toured Canada: *Susan G. Scott: Works from 1974 to 1983*, *Blindman's Buff* (1988-1991) and *Les enfants terribles* (2003-2005). Her work can be found in permanent collections in Canada and Europe including *Art Gallery of Nova Scotia*, *Nickle Arts Museum*, *Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal*, and *Collection du Fonds régional d'art contemporain d'île-de-France*.
